#### ACB's role in the ASEAN Region


- Enhance the region's digital biodiversity knowledge capacity by establishing links to networks of knowledge holders

- Asian Nodes Regional Workshop of the GBIF, Ivy Hall, Aoyama, Tokyo, March 1 −2, 2012
  - ACB as Asia Node representative 2012 2014
  - Identified gaps in GBIF representation in Asia, means to move forward through better understanding of GBIF, incentive for data mobilization, increased data use, strengthen regional nodes
- Third Regional Meeting of the GBIF Participant Nodes in Asia was held on 28 – 30 June 2012, in Taipei, Taiwan.
  - Asia Regional Plan of Action
    - Making species checklists at national level, including invasive, Red List, endemic species and migratory birds; and
    - Updating fish databases to assess fish biodiversity loss and risk in Asia.

- Workshop on integrated Red List/Invasive Species List / Check List in East Asia, National Museum of Nature and Science, Tsukuba, Ibaraki, Japan, 12 – 13 March, 2013
  - Promote understanding of the importance of the Red List (RL), Invasive Species List (IL) and Check List (CL)
  - Survey current status of RL/IL/CL in East Asia
  - Determine strategy for integration of RL/IL/CL in East Asia
  - Data collected from ASEAN countries can be a) published through ACB's IPT, b) set up an IPT for each country, and c) each country to be assisted to publish a RedList and IAS for their country.




